YMCA Resident Camp

Please be informed of the following requirements for attending YMCA Resident Camp in 2010 that apply to you and your child(ren) right now.

- All requirements from previous sponsored events must be fulfilled.
- Child must attend the Youth Center 40% of the time, or two times a week.
- Child must meet behavior requirements at the Youth Center throughout the school year and summer.
- Parent and child(ren) must participate in a fundraiser activity.
- The only required payment will be a nonrefundable \$20.00 reservation fee for the first child in the family and \$10.00 additional for each additional child. This can be paid as early as May 1, 2010 and as late as June 30, 2010 at the Youth Center to the Supervisor. July 1, 2010 to August 13, 2010 the reservation fee will be \$25.00 for the first child in the family and an additional \$10.00 for each additional child.



Flower Fundraiser



As many of you are already aware, through our program children have been sent to YMCA Resident Camp free of charge. Due to high attendance we have made some changes to the program to ensure that your children can continue to use this program. This summer it is required that the family of a child or children who wish to attend YMCA Resident Camp participate in at least one fundraiser. The flower fundraiser is an easy opportunity to help. On March 8, 2010 you can pick up your selling materials and start selling flowers from the catalog, taking payments, recording customer information and then on March 19, 2010 you will return all the forms and payments to the Youth Center. It's as easy as that. When the flowers arrive you will receive a phone call and will deliver them to your customers. Each family only needs to help with one fundraiser regardless of the number of children they plan to send to YMCA Resident Camp. You can sell to friends, family, coworkers, neighbors and you can sign up for a time to sit in the entryway of the YMCA and sell to Y members. A parent/guardian must pick up the forms for children younger than 12. You are responsible for the customer's money while it is in your possession. Any lost or stolen money must be replaced by you. If you do not have a child attending summer camp, feel free to help sell flowers to support the Youth Center and our community's children.
